Booth description: 12' x 12' space on either 7th Street or High Street. Vendors provide canopy, tables, and any display equipment. Tables must be draped to the ground.

Electricity is available only on 7th Street for an additional \$20.00 fee. Power is for lighting only, no space heaters. Only one duplex outlet per vendor, and vendor must provide 1-100' #12 power cord, per circuit UL approved. All electrical cords will be inspected. If cord does not meet requirements, a cord can be rented at an additional charge of \$30.00, as supply allows. Rented cords will be returned at end of event. (A charge of \$100.00 per cord will be billed on non-returned cords.) All extension cords will be plugged into an approved GFCI receptacle provided. All connections to power will be inspected. Safety of vendors and general public is a top priority. Electrical issues must be brought to the attention of event planners. Vendors will not open up any panel boxes/outlet boxes to make connections or repairs. Event planners will have qualified electricians on site for such issues. No electricity is available on High Street.

Electrical set-up for 7th Street booths will begin Friday afternoon, November 26th, and street closures will begin at 7:00 pm. **7th Street vendor early set-up may NOT begin prior to 7:00 pm and is at your own risk. There will NOT be security officers on duty overnight. 7th Street vendors will NOT be able to break down their booth until the close of this event, at approximately 9:00 pm.**

High Street Vendors will NOT be able to set up until Saturday morning. High Street Vendors between 6th & 7th Streets will be required to close their booths by 5:00 pm & box all of their equipment/tent by 5:30 pm to clear the street. High Street vendors between 7th & 8th Streets will be required to close their booths by 5:30 pm and box all their equipment/tent by 6:00 pm to clear the street.

Note: Booths that offer any food items for sale must have the appropriate food permit as required by Kendall County and the State of Texas. More information will be provided if you are accepted for this event.

All vendors must adhere to State, County & CDC guidelines & will have temperatures checked upon arrival; if above 100 degrees, then regretfully you will not be able to participate in the event.

This event will go on rain or shine. No refunds will be issued for vendor cancellations for any reason.

Please note that this is an Arts & Crafts Festival, and while not all items must be handmade, they need to fit well into the arts & crafts atmosphere of the event.

COVID-19 special considerations: It is the responsibility of the Vendor to adhere to all State, County and CDC requirements regarding masks, social distancing and other COVID-19 related regulations. If it becomes necessary for the Chamber to cancel the event due to a COVID-related spike in cases or any other circumstances due to COVID, The Chamber will refund Vendor rental fees less \$25 processing costs and any expenses paid by The Chamber on behalf of the Vendor, such as the procurement of Temporary Food Permits. Individual Vendor decisions to not go forward with the event do not qualify for a refund.
